

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment Terms

Our price is subject to the acceptance of our terms and conditions as stated in this proposal.

Progress payment will apply as per below for this project.

40% of contract sum on acceptance

40% of contract sum on installation of footings

20% on completion of project

Terms and Conditions

A. TRADING TERMS

Your first project payment of 40% is to be paid to Weathersafe Shades upon written acceptance of this contract or placement of a purchase order, unless otherwise agreed in writing. This contract has a cooling off period of 5 business days. The quoted price is in Australian dollars and is valid for one calendar month. Any requested variations to the original contract price must be in writing. Tax invoices will be issued by Weathersafe Shades on completion of each stage of this contract, and are payable strictly 7 days net of completion date of work, unless otherwise agreed in writing at the time of quotation. Any retention held will not exceed 2.5% for 60 days, after which time collection costs will apply. All goods, supplied and installed shall remain the property of Weathersafe Shades until paid in full. Weathersafe Shades have the right to enter premises and remove the structure made by our company if payment is not received within the agreed period. Collection costs will be incurred at a rate of 20% per annum or part thereof, of outstanding amounts due if trading terms are exceeded. Further legal and court costs may apply.

B. ACCESS AND FACILITIES

Weathersafe Shades assumes delivery using a small truck within 10m of installed position. Structure will not be carried up stairs, in lift shafts or through finished buildings, unless specifically agreed in writing at the time of quotation. Protection to finished surfaces, working over established plants, or loss of access to easily install our product, that was not clearly identified on preliminary drawings or highlighted at the time of the quotation, may be subject to a variation claim on this contract. Weathersafe Shades will take all reasonable care to prevent damage to existing paths, driveways etc but will not accept any responsibility for damage to existing paths, driveways etc, in the course of erecting the structure. Specialist services e.g.: paving, plumbing, electrics or concreting if required, are typically outside the scope of our offer and will need to be arranged separately, unless requested and specified within our quotation. It is an assumption of being on your premises to do the work described above, that any vehicle or machinery used on the site is there with your approval. Single-phase power, water, toilet facilities, and suitable rubbish receptacles are to be provided during installation. Weathersafe Shades will provide barricades where and when required. Weathersafe Shades have assumed unrestricted access to the site from 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday. Works performed outside of these hours may incur a labour surcharge, unless otherwise specified and agreed.

C. EXCAVATION AND POURING OF FOUNDATIONS

Foundations are to be dug by machine (bobcat and auger or drilling rig) and the concrete placed by truck, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

The price quoted is for a clear, level site and any filling, compacting, levelling and hand digging etc will be charged an extra \$100.00 + GST per man, per hour plus rock drills, special excavation plant, cranes or concrete pumps. Soil from excavations will be left on site unless otherwise agreed in writing. Mini skip bins or tipper trucks are not supplied unless specified in the written quotation. The location of any footings, foundations or holes to be dug is to be discussed with the client. Any repairs and consequential damage caused by unidentified services that are damaged during excavations are to be paid for by the client, including waiting time and machine costs. Any relocation of footings and/or foundations as a consequence of section 4 above or for any other reason as decided by the client, will be charged to the client, including machine costs, labour time, accommodation costs and waiting time as applicable.

D. EXCLUSIONS

No allowance has been made for gutters, down-pipes, drainage or detailed services unless specified in the quotation.

Weathersafe Shades has assumed that any existing foundations or structural attachment points will take the applied load strength. The client is responsible for confirming this with their engineer.

The job is as quoted. Any modifications, additional work that was not quoted for may be charged back to the client. This will be documented and invoiced.

E. APPROVALS

The client shall be liable for the cost of obtaining relevant approvals from the relevant local authority, and any building permit, licence or the like required pursuant to the laws of South Australia, in respect to the works as described in this contract, unless otherwise agreed in writing.

F. GUARANTEES

All manufacturers' material warranties will be passed to the client. The client cannot pursue Weathersafe Shades for product warranties beyond that offered by the manufacturer. The client is limited to the replacement of defective materials or faulty workmanship. The client shall do all in their power that is reasonable to mitigate losses occurring from any perceived or actual defect. Alterations, additions or damage made by others invalidates any Weathersafe quarantee. Failure to maintain membrane and structures with cleaning and annual inspections may void warranty claims.

This contract is issued unaltered from section A-F. Handwritten additions or alterations made on this contract are not acceptable. Any addition or alteration to this contract must be received on a separate document, to be determined and accepted, dated and signed by an authorised officer of Weathersafe Shades for such addition to form part of this contract.
