PROJECT OBJECTIVE

To create a community space that can cater for recreational activity and community events - incorporating large green space, toilet amenities, play space, fitness zone, walking/running track in conjunction with the walk of remembrance.

ZONING & ELEMENTS

PASSIVE

- 1 CARPARKS**
 Located within close proximity to amenity/entry features. An access road connects both parking lots along the western side of the reserve. This road provides access to adjacent sheds and facilities including the Bowls club and tennis courts.
- 2 ACCESS ROAD**
- 3 SHELTERED AMENITIES**
 Situated amongst active areas of the Reserve these zones provide a rest stop and shade area for park users. Large fixed shelter's cover amenities including picnic tables and benches, drinking fountains, bins and BBQ's.

- 4 MEMORIAL SPACE**
 Retain existing Memorial statue and incorporate area into new design. Create connections across the Reserve that form a relationship to the Memorial.
- 5 MEMORIAL WALK**
 Design a formal path with complementary trees/planting and feature points at each end of the walk. Implement creative wayfinding techniques to highlight the walk to and from the Memorial. This could include signage, plaques and information markers.

- 6 NATIVE REGENERATION ZONES**
 Use of native shrubs, grasses and trees to accentuate local flora and endemic species for the area. Opportunity to work with NRM and possible volunteer groups to develop revegetation.
- 7 OPEN GREEN SPACE**
 Large engaged oval allows for greater sport activities and can cater for community events and social gatherings.
- 8 FITNESS ZONE**
 Install various exercise equipment for all ages. Installation of some equipment for seniors.

- 9 RUNNING/WALKING TRACK**
 Create an informal path network that connects various zones and loops the Reserve. This also provides seating nodes along the path for rest and points of interest. Signage from areas of self-walk through and mark distances along the way.
- 10 ADVENTURE PLAY**
 Install new play equipment to suit explorative, active and adventurous play experiences.

- 11 NATURE PLAY**
 Natural play areas with rocks, logs, natural gravel and additional play elements to create unstructured and explorative nature based play opportunities for kids.

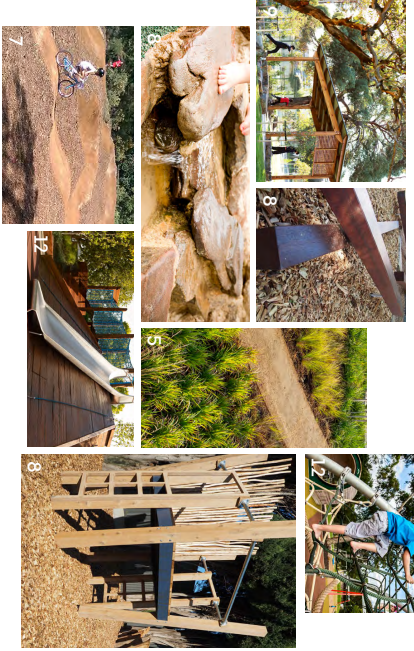

ELEMENTS & PRECEDENT IMAGERY

- 1 **MEMORIAL SPACE**
 Retain existing Memorial statue and incorporate area into new design. Connections created across the Reserve form a commemorative relationship to the Memorial.
- 2 **MEMORIAL WALK**
 New paved path with feature information markers. Each end showcases a sculptural also provides seating nodes for rest and points of interest.
- 3 **RUNNING/WALKING TRACK**
 New compacted rubble path network that connects various zones and loops the distance along the way.
- 4 **TREE AVENUE**
 Large spaced trees spaced evenly along the Memorial walk to complement the site's existing landscape and softens play zones.
- 5 **NATIVE REVEGETATION ZONES**
 Native shrubs, grasses and trees used to accentuate local flora and endemic species for the area.
- 6 **AMPHITHEATRE**
 Low raised seating to accommodate existing fall of landscape and create unstructured play and seating opportunities.
- 7 **BMX PUMP TRACK**
 Blue track on existing flat zone with mounds, turns and ramps encouraging active play for various ages.
- 8 **NATURE PLAY**
 Natural creek bed area with rocks, logs, natural gravel and timber play towers to create unstructured and explorative nature based play opportunities for kids.
- 9 **SHUTTERED AMENITIES**
 Situated amongst active zones of the Reserve, these zones provide a rest, stop and picnic area for park users. Large fixed shelters cover amenities including picnic tables and benches, drinking fountains, bins and BBQs.
- 10 **OPEN GREEN SPACE**
 Large irrigated oval allowing for greater number of sport activities and community events in local festivals/markets.
- 11 **FITNESS ZONE**
 Encouraging upper body and mobility strength with exercise equipment for various ages. Installation of some equipment included specifically for senior use.
- 12 **ADVENTURE PLAY**
 New play equipment to suit active and adventurous play experiences. This zone uses banchip to provide adequate softfall under play elements.
- 13 **CARPARKS**
 Enclosed carparks located within close proximity to amenities/park features.
- 14 **ACCESS ROAD**
 Burmed road connecting both parking lots along the western side of the Reserve. This road provides access to the public and accessed via deciduous boom gates.
