ELEMENTS & PRECEDENT IMAGERY



MEMORIAL SPACE

Retain existing Memorial statue and incorporate area into new design. Connections created across the Reserve form a commerative relationship to the Memorial.

MEMORIAL WALK

New paved path with feature information markers. Each end showcases a sculptural. totem piece highlighting the walk to and from the Memorial. This structured path also provides seating nodes for rest and points of interest.



RUNNING/WALKING TRACK

New compacted rubble path network that connects various zones and loops the Reserve. Track incorporates signage/markers to aid avid runners and indicate distances along the way

TREE AVENUE

Large, shade trees spaced evenly along the Memorial walk to compliment the surrounding landscape and adjacent plantings.

NATIVE REVEGETATION ZONES

Native shrubs, grasses and trees used to accentuate local flora and endemic species for the area.



Low raised walling to accommidate existing fall of landscape and create unstructured play and seating opp ortunities.

BMX PUMPTRACK

Bike track on existing flat zone with mounds, burms and ramps encouraging active play for various ages.



NATURE PLAY

Natural creek bed area with rocks, logs, natural gravels and timber play towers to create unstructured and explorative nature based play opportunities for kids.

SHELTERED AMENITIES

Situated amongst active areas of the Reserve, these zones provide a rest stop and picnic area for park users. Large fixed shelters cover amenities including, picnic tables and benches, drinking fountains, bins and BBQs.



Large imigated oval allowing for greater number of sport activites and community events inc. local fairs/markets

FITNESS ZONE

Encouraging upperbody and mobility strength with exercise equipment for various ages. Installation of some equipment included specifically for senior use.



ADVENTURE PLAY

New play equipment to suit active and adventurous play experiences. This zone uses bankchip to provide adequate softfall under play elements.



CARPARKS Bitumised carparks located within close proximity to amenities/park features.

ACCESS ROAD


Bitumised road connecting both parking lots along the western side of the reserve. This road provides access to adjacent sheds and facilities inc Bowls club and Tennis courts. These are closed to the public and accessed via lockable boom gates.
